NOMINATION PROCEDURE

Nominations for recipients of the 2010 Leadership Award is requested from CASE members in District VIII. The CASE District VIII Leadership Award recognizes a district member institution president or head, chancellor, educational system head, or CEO for outstanding efforts to promote the understanding and support of education. Nominees must have demonstrated the following:

- created a vision for an institution and inspire others to accept that vision,
- established a positive image for the institution, and/or successfully led an institution through turbulent times,
- increased an institution's stature in its community and its educational service to the community,
- and be innovative and encouraged an institution's personnel to be innovative and take risks.

Nominees must be with an institutional member of CASE District VIII, which includes member primary and secondary schools, two-year colleges, four-year colleges and universities, and educational systems in Alaska, Alberta, British Columbia, Idaho, Oregon, Manitoba, Montana, Northwest Territories, Nunavut, Saskatchewan, Washington and Yukon Territories.

Those making nominations are asked to submit:

- **A completed Official Nomination Form** or a computer-generated form which provides exactly the same information in the same order as on this form (on right).
- **A Nominating Statement** not to exceed 500 words, describing the nominator's association with the nominee and her/his accomplishments.
- **A resume and other background information, documents, or letters of endorsement** detailing the nominee's service and/or leadership.

The Distinguished Leadership Award is presented at the CASE District VIII Annual Conference. The 2010 Conference is scheduled February 17-20 in Portland, Oregon. (Visit www.case8.org often for emerging information on the conference.)

The award is presented only in years when outstanding candidates can be identified and are available to attend the awards ceremony. Award winner are expected to provide their own lodging and travel expenses. Notification is scheduled to take place by December 4, 2009.
